Doll Model Size

- Head circumference is 11 - 12"
- 18 inch dolls such as American Girl®
- 16 inch Disney® Animator's Collection Doll

You Will Need

FABRIC TYPE – Fleece

- Fabric – 6" x 22"
- Matching Thread
- Fabric Pencil or Pen Marker



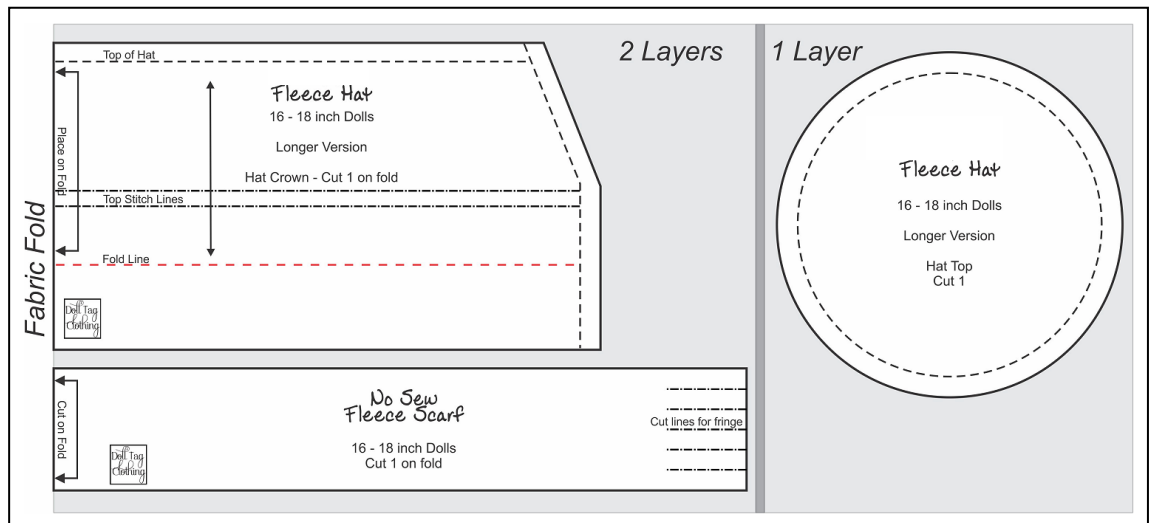
Printing the Pattern

- A PDF reader is required to view and print the files (Recommended Adobe Reader).
- Pattern pieces are at the end of the instructions. They are designed to fit on an 8.5" x 11" standard US paper.
- Check the pattern scale. There is no resizing necessary. Print files at 100%, "Scale None", or "Actual Size".
- If you are using A4 Paper set and your scale is not correct, set your printer to print "Letter" size.
- Simply cut out the pattern pieces or trace them onto pattern paper.

Cutting List & Layout

- Two hat lengths Included. Cut your preferred length.
- Scarf Measurement – 1.5" x 17"

1x Hat Crown on Fold
 1x Hat Top
 1x Scarf on Fold



Hat Instructions

- Fleece does not fray so will not need to be finished with a zigzag or serger.
- Seam allowance – Sew a 1/4” seam unless otherwise stated.
- CLIP and NOTCH the Curves – Internal curves are clipped and external curves are notched at regular intervals. This allows for a flat curve when the seam is turned.

1. With right sides together, fold the hat crown in half lengthways and sew the short side.



2. Fold the bottom hem up towards the wrong side – 1”. Pin in place.
3. Sew two rows of stitches close to the fabric edge. Sew them about 1/4” apart. I used a triple stitch on my machine, set to stitch length 3.



4. Divide the Hat top into four sections. Divide the top of the hat crown into four sections. Align these marks with one another and pin.
5. Sew the seam. Remove the pins.

Turn the hat right side out.

The Hat is Complete!



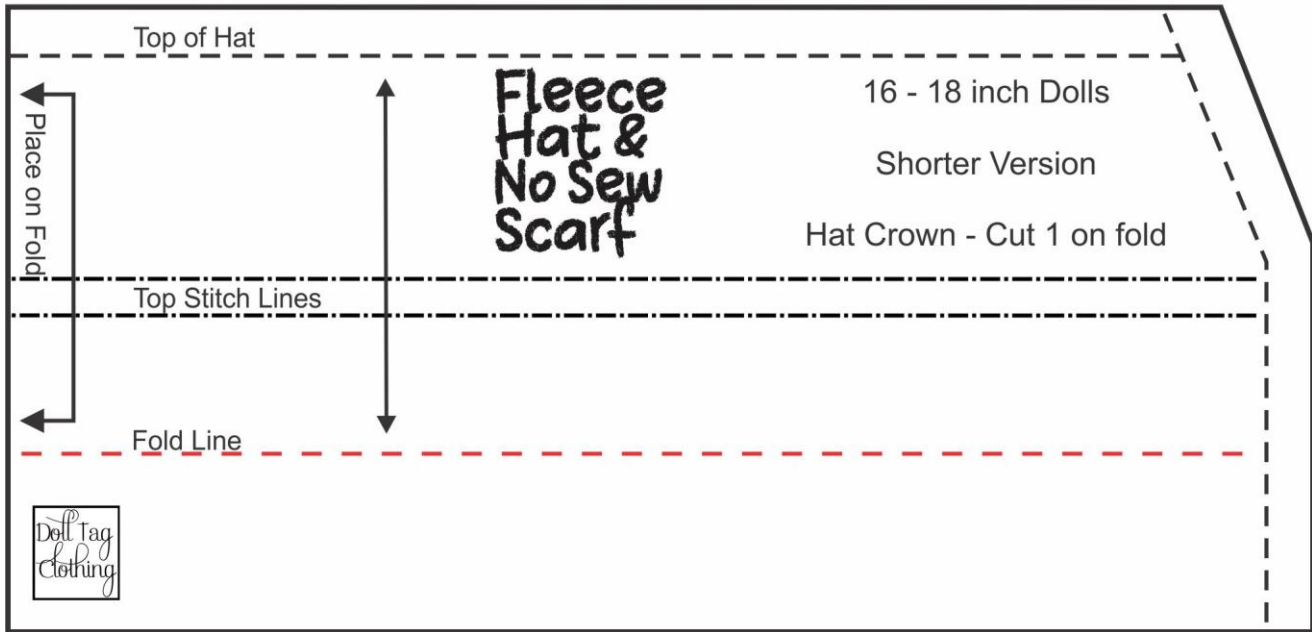
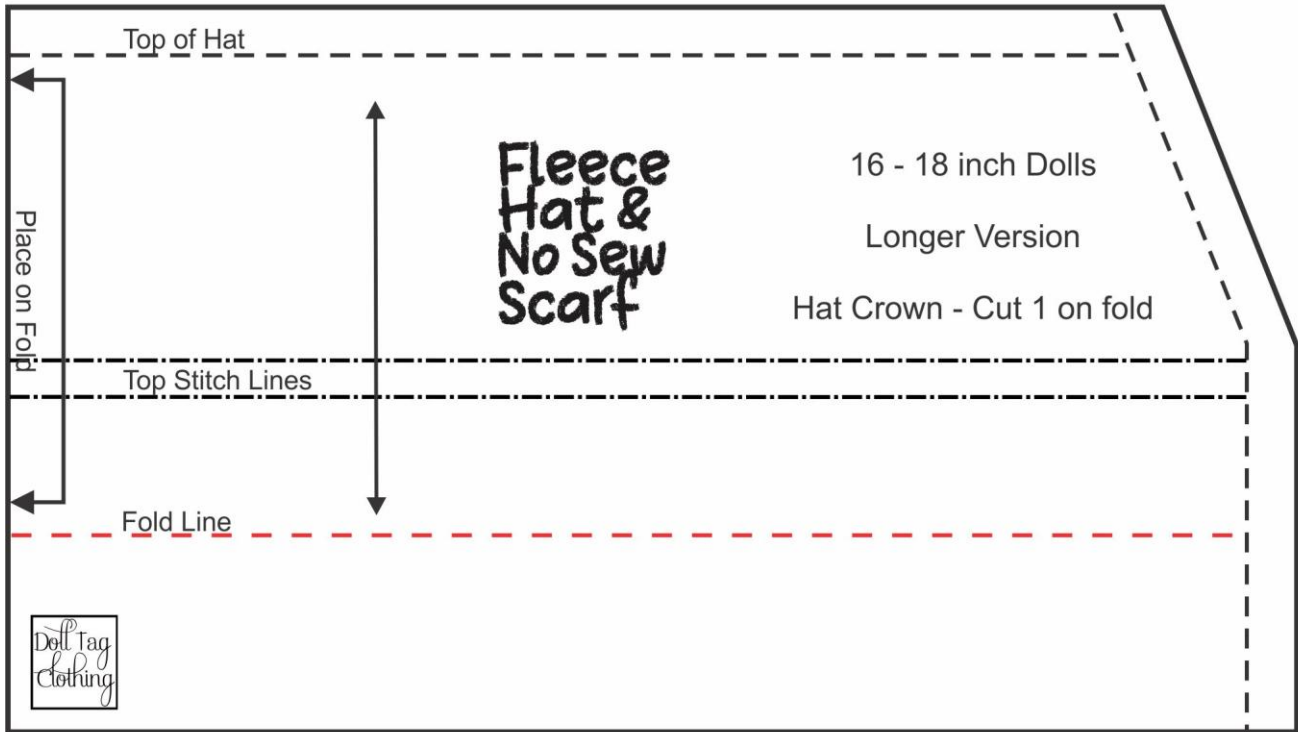
No-Sew Scarf Instructions

- You can change the size of the scarf to adapt it to different dolls.
 - Fleece does not fray so will not need to be finished with a zigzag or serger.
1. At the two short ends of the scarf, cut the fringe. Cut 1" deep and make each cut 1/4" apart. Also shown on the pattern piece.

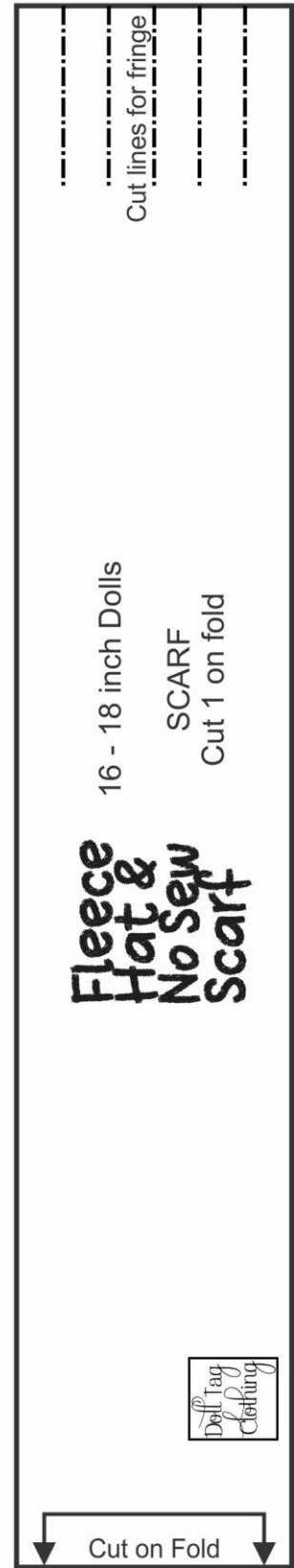
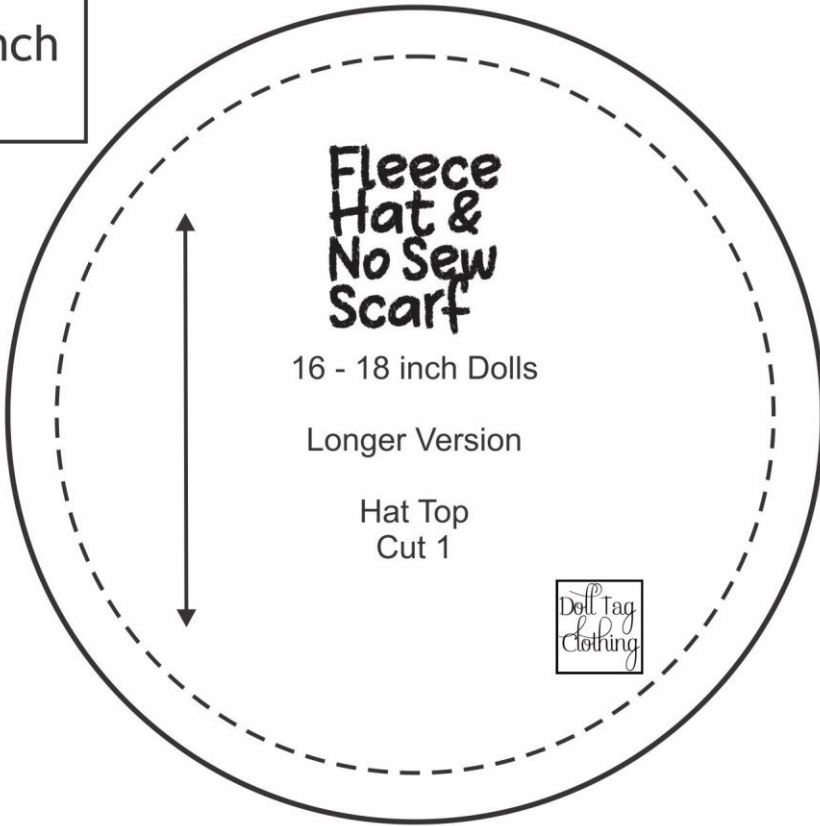
